

## “SOCIETY ACT”

### CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is “North Peace Justice Society”
2. The purposes of the Society are:
  - (a) To develop and provide a Restorative Justice Program where the victims and offenders (with the assistance of a trained facilitator) agree on restitution;
  - (b) To receive funds and grants and to administer the same, consistent with the purposes of the Society;
  - (c) To purchase and/or lease such assets as may be necessary or appropriate to further the purposes of the Society;
3. The Society shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting its purposes. This provision is unalterable.
4. In the event of winding up or dissolution of the Society, voluntary or otherwise, the remaining assets of the Society, after all the debts have been paid or provision for payment has been made, shall be paid, transferred or delivered to such non-profit organization or society as the members direct. This provision may not be altered pursuant to Section 22 of the **Society Act**.

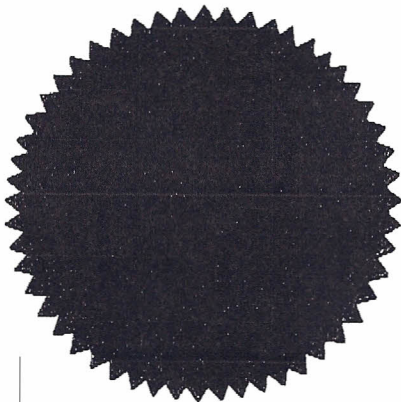
